This document is now available for ADME members on the Members Only page <http://www.adme.org/MemberArea/default.asp> This DMC Agreement for Services is the final contract between the DMC and the client. It covers all the obligations and costs, and makes provisions for how changes are handled. There will be slight variations depending on each jurisdiction, but the essence remains the same from one DMC to another. This final document incorporates standard clauses to cover all aspects of DMC work. ADME recommends that you have your corporate attorney review this document to ensure that it meets your state laws and requirements.
